

## WALK 4 Alternative if you want a later time of arrival time at The Alma

From section 4

At the road there is a three-way junction. Take the middle road (ignoring roads to left & right). Walk along Linton Ridge for approx  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile until you come to field gate & stile on your left. Cross this stile & walk straight across the field to another stile in the far fence. Cross this stile & continue on the same line to stile & steps onto a road.

Cross road & down a very rough track. Ignore footpath on right & then the left, walk past the farmhouse to a footpath sign on your right by a large willow tree. Walk along this path keeping the stream on your right. Cross over a stile (or a gap in the fence where a gate should be) Continue in the same direction. Pass through a small metal gate into a garden. Proceed through the garden until you reach a stile on your right (owners are aware that the path goes through their garden) Pass over this stile back into the field. (Do not cross the stile onto the road). Then bare right uphill keeping the hedge & stream on your left.

When the field narrows you reach some steps & a stile. Cross over the stile & turn left. Keep the hedge & stream on the left & walk to a stile. Cross over this stile & walk along the path, crossing a small stream, until you reach the road. Turn right & walk along the road to The Alma on your left. On leaving The Alma walk along the road towards the Church. Walk through the Church Yard, keeping the Church on your left, ignoring gravel path on your right, to a gate in the wall. Walk through the gate & along the path keeping the village hall wall on your right to the road. This path might be overgrown so walk through the village hall car park to the road. Turn left & walk downhill. At the bottom of the hill, turn right. Walk along this road & follow the instructions from section 9.
